

## POLICY FOR QUALITY CONTROL AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

The Board of Directors of Mattiussi Ecologia S.p.A. recognises quality control and environmental protection as essential objectives for its competitive strategy and, consequently, decided to bring its company management system in line with the models proposed by ISO 9001 and ISO 14001.

The General Management of Mattiussi Ecologia S.p.A. promotes the policy for quality control and environmental protection at all levels of the company organisation, so that it is understood and implemented.

In order to reach these targets Mattiussi Ecologia S.p.A. guarantees its constant commitment to achieving the following objectives:

- customer satisfaction;
- continuous improvement of the effectiveness of the quality control and environmental protection system;
- compliance with the applicable laws, regulations and standards;
- constant updating of the existing products and introduction of new models on the basis of market needs, favouring recovery and recycling as much as possible;
- use of technologies with a low pollution potential and with a low consumption of energy and natural resources, systematically measuring every direct or indirect impact of the processes controlled;
- reducing the production of scrap and waste, carefully managing the treatment;
- integrating sustainability considerations into all our business decisions, from transportation to the consumption of resources and working practices;
- favouring suppliers who comply with and adopt a correct environmental management system;
- training of all employees on environmental and sustainability issues.

This policy, which is defined and updated by the Mattiussi Ecologia S.p.A. management, is communicated to all employees, suppliers and active or potential customers. The general objectives expressed in the policy are developed in detail in the quality control and environmental protection programmes.

Since the quality control and environmental protection policy is considered to be of primary importance, the Board of Directors has granted the Quality Control Officer with the authority to set up and maintain a company system in accordance with ISO 9001 and ISO 14001.

The role of Quality Control Officer will be covered by the Managing Director, who will delegate the responsibilities for management and technical coordination of the System to the Quality Assurance Manager.

The importance of the objectives to be achieved requires the constant commitment of all the company personnel, for what must be a definitive decision.
